

Antique Mirror 1-Year Limited Warranty

Dreamwalls Antique Mirrors, proudly manufactured in North Carolina, come with a 1-year limited warranty. This warranty is extended only to the original purchaser of the new, unused product and applies solely to antique mirrors installed within the United States or Canada.

This warranty guarantees against significant defects in the silver film which substantively affect the mirror's appearance for a period of 1 year from the date of purchase, provided that the mirror is properly installed in a suitable environment, using compatible glazing materials, and maintained correctly. Proper maintenance includes using appropriate cleaning materials.

Characteristics of Antique Mirrors

Antique mirrors are mirrors that look aged or distressed by years of use and exposure. While you still occasionally find a mirror that comes by this effect naturally, more commonly it's been achieved intentionally. Dreamwalls Antique Mirror achieves this effect by modern silvering technology that produces the look of a vintage mirror.

Antique mirror is produced by modifying the normal silvering process, and the pattern will vary slightly from sheet to sheet.

Warranty Limitations and Exclusions

The float glass we use to make antique mirrors is supplied by primary glass manufacturers and is manufactured in compliance with ASTM C1503 Standard Specification for Silvered Flat Glass Mirror. Inherent in the float glass process are some small gaseous inclusions and minor abrasions. Occasional small "bubbles" and hairlines are, therefore, perfectly normal and acceptable under these Standards and should be virtually unnoticeable from a normal viewing distance.

The antique mirrors must be installed according to industry-accepted glazing processes and with commercially acceptable glazing materials.

This limited warranty does not cover:

- Any characteristics inherent in the antique mirror manufacturing process, as described above.
- Pattern variation
- Deterioration caused by contaminants attacking the silver layer at an exposed edge.
- Scratches, chips, water spots, or breakage.
- Damage to the edges.
- Costs associated with removal or reinstallation.
- Damage resulting from improper use, storage, shipping, handling, installation, or modification.
- Damage due to natural disasters or other uncontrollable events.
- Mirror that has been subject to standing water or other liquids.
- Mirror that has been fitted with any type of solar control film applied to the glass surface.
- Installations in high-moisture environments including, but not limited to, swimming pool enclosures, bath enclosures, watercraft, greenhouses, commercial refrigeration products, etc.

- Installations in high-vibration environments including, but not limited to, motor vehicles and trailers.
- Outdoor, unusual, or exotic installations.
- Material that has not been paid for in full or has been discarded or destroyed.

In the event of a warranty claim, Dreamwalls, at its discretion, will either:

1. Repair the mirror,
2. Replace the mirror (F.O.B Dreamwalls' plant), or
3. Refund the purchase price.

All claims must be submitted in writing to Dreamwalls and must include proof of purchase.

Installation and Maintenance Guidelines

- Do not install mirrors on unpainted plaster, drywall, or cement walls, as lime can leach through the mirror backing.
- Avoid installing mirrors on newly painted walls as solvents can soften the mirror backing.
- Ensure adequate air space between the mirror and the supporting wall or surface.
- In wet areas such as bathrooms and kitchens, install mirrors off the bases to prevent water pooling at the bottom edge.

Additional Terms

Dreamwalls reserves the right to inspect the product and conduct its own tests to determine the cause of any defect. Dreamwalls shall not be liable for any special, consequential, or incidental damages arising from the use or application of its mirror products.

Any replacement mirrors provided under a warranty claim are covered only until the expiration of the original warranty period for the replaced mirror.
